



Volunteering-Piedmont Park Conservancy 2020

We are appreciative of our volunteers and all they do to assist us with helping to keep Piedmont Park, clean, green and sustainable. Before you volunteer in the park please read the following guidelines.

What you need to know before you volunteer in Piedmont Park.

Volunteer opportunities are by **appointment only**

You must fill out, and **return the waiver by email before you volunteer**. If you don't sign the waiver, send a photograph for verification purposes.

Once we have your waiver on file you may just send an email to sign up for future volunteer opportunities.

Mondays and Thursdays for Trash Pickup. 8:30-12 noon. Individuals

arrive between 8:30 and 9am at the outside of the Conservancy Offices where supplies are distributed-gloves, trash grabbers and plastic bags. Return grabbers by or before 12 noon. Send an email to Erica Glasener to report your hours.

Wednesdays from 9am to 12 noon (limited to 15 people) landscape projects including weeding, removing invasive plants, pruning, mulching and planting.

Currently we will not be accepting any unscheduled volunteers.

Projects will start promptly on time. Late arrivals will not be permitted to participate. We will give a 10 minute grace period for all volunteers.

If you are sick with COVID-19, were recently exposed (within 14 days) to someone with COVID-19, or just don't feel well, please **DO NOT** volunteer. Please also note that we reserve the right to refuse volunteers displaying COVID-19 symptoms. For more information visit

What we provide:

The project- weeding, removing invasive plants, mulching, pruning, planting.

Tools that have been sanitized.

Instruction and a structure that allows for volunteers to work six feet apart.

Small groups spread out. Currently we limit groups to 15.

Soap and water for washing available in public bathroom.

What you *should* bring with you:

Gloves-(if needed we can provide one pair for you to then take home,)

A mask is recommended but not required.

PLEASE Bring your own water bottle with water.

Wear close toed shoes, lightweight long pants and a long sleeved shirt.

If you have your own hand pruners or other tools please feel free to bring them.

The Conservancy offices (a two story gray stone building across from Magnolia Hall) are next to the Welcome Plaza in the Park. This is easily accessible from the lowest level, level one of the Sage Parking Garage, the same garage used for the Atlanta Botanical Garden. To enter by car use 1320 Monroe Drive, Atlanta, GA 30306 address.
